

2004 OKLAHOMA JUDO ASSOCIATION (OJA) ANNUAL AWARDS

ALL AWARDS RECIPIENTS MUST BE MEMBERS OF THE OJA. ONLY POINTS EARNED SINCE REGISTRATION WITH THE OJA ARE INCLUDED. TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR ONE OF THE COMPETITOR AWARDS AN OJA MEMBER MUST HAVE ENTERED AT LEAST 2 OF THE INCLUDED TOURNAMENTS DURING THE AWARD PERIOD. USJI MEMBERS TRANSFERING TO OKLAHOMA WILL BE CONSIDER-ED AS OJA MEMBERS FOR THAT PART OF THE YEAR AFTER WHICH THEY ARE RESIDENTS OF OKLAHOMA, BUT WILL BE EXPECTED TO REGISTER WITH THE OJA THEREAFTER.

COACHING AWARDS:

IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR ONE OF THE COACHING AWARDS A COACH MUST BE A CURRENT OJA MEMBER & NORMALLY, MUST HAVE AT LEAST TWO PLAYERS EARNING POINTS IN THE RESPECTIVE AGE CATEGORY. CLUB TOTALS ARE DETERMINED BY THE TOTAL NUMBER OF POINTS EARNED BY PLAYERS OF THAT CLUB, IN EACH AGE CATEGORY (see further clarification of point totals used under SYMBOLS on the next page).

OUTSTANDING ATHLETE AWARDS:

THESE AWARDS ARE GIVEN TO THE ATHLETE IN EACH AGE CATEGORY WHO HAS ACCUMULATED THE HIGHEST TOTAL OF POINTS.

MOST IMPROVED ATHLETE AWARDS:

THESE AWARDS ARE GIVEN TO THE ATHLETE IN EACH AGE CATEGORY WHO, AFTER SUBTRACT-ING THE PREVIOUS YEAR'S POINT TOTAL FROM THE PRESENT YEAR'S POINT TOTAL, HAS THE HIGHEST REMAINING TOTAL OF POINTS (MOST IMPROVED POINTS). PREVIOUS YEARS' POINT TOTALS ARE HALVED IF THEY WERE EARNED IN A YOUNGER DIVISION. NO PREVIOUS YEARS' POINT TOTALS FROM JUNIOR DIVISIONS ARE SUBTRACTED FROM SENIOR DIVISION POINTS. IN THE CASE WHERE NO ATHLETE HAS ANY MOST IMPROVED POINTS, THE RUNNER-UP FOR THE OUTSTANDING ATHLETE AWARD SHALL RECEIVE THIS AWARD.

OUTSTANDING NEWCOMER AWARDS:

THESE AWARDS ARE GIVEN TO THE ATHLETE IN EACH AGE CATEGORY WHO HAS ACCUMULATED THE HIGHEST TOTAL OF POINTS, & WHOSE RANK AT THE BEGINNING OF THE YEAR (RBY) WAS EITHER WHITE OR YELLOW BELT (SRS.: WHITE BELT - ROKYU (6K); JRS.: J1-J3). IN THE CASE WHERE NO ATHLETE OF THE DESIGNATED RANKS HAS ANY POINTS THAN THE LOWEST RANKING ATHLETE WITH POINTS SHALL WIN THIS AWARD, PROVIDED THAT THE ATHLETE HAS RECEIVED NO OTHER OJA AWARD IN PREVIOUS YEARS.

MULTIPLE AWARDS:

IT IS THE POLICY OF THE OJA AWARDS COMMITTEE THAT ANY INDIVIDUAL MEMBER OF THE OJA SHALL RECEIVE ONLY ONE COMPETITION OR COACHING AWARD IN ANY GIVEN YEAR. WHERE ONE MEMBER OF THE OJA HAS ALREADY WON A COACHING OR COMPETITOR AWARD IN ONE CATEGORY & QUALIFIES FOR AN AWARD IN A SECOND CATEGORY, THE OJA MEMBER SHALL RECEIVE THE AWARD FOR WHICH HE/SHE HAD THE HIGHER POINT TOTAL OR HIGHER AVERAGE. WHERE THE POINT TOTALS ARE THE SAME, THE OJA MEMBER SHALL HAVE HIS/HER CHOICE OF AWARDS & THE OJA MEMBER PLACING SECOND IN THE REJECTED CATEGORY SHALL WIN THAT AWARD. WHERE THE OJA MEMBER IS ELIGIBLE FOR AN AWARD DUE TO PLACING SECOND IN ONE CATEGORY (WHICH WAS REJECTED BY THE OJA MEMBER WHO PLACED FIRST) & IS ELIGIBLE FOR ANOTHER AWARD DUE TO PLACING FIRST IN A SECOND CATEGORY, THE OJA MEMBER SHALL WIN THE AWARD HE/SHE WON OUTRIGHT REGARDLESS OF THE POINT TOTAL OR AVERAGE IN THE FIRST CATEGORY.

SPECIAL AWARDS:

1. OUTSTANDING OFFICIAL OF THE YEAR - THIS AWARD IS GRANTED TO THE OJA MEMBER WHO HAS SHOWN THE GREATEST IMPROVEMENT IN OFFICIATING ABILITY DURING THE YEAR. ONLY OJA

MEMBERS CERTIFIED LOWER THAN NATIONAL CLASS OFFICIAL ARE ELIGIBLE FOR THIS AWARD. THE RECIPIENT OF THIS AWARD SHALL BE DECIDED BY THE OJA REFEREE COMMITTEE (ALL OJA MEMBERS WHO ARE CERTIFIED AS CLASS N OR HIGHER OFFICIALS).

2. SPORTSMANSHIP AWARDS - THE RECIPIENTS OF THESE AWARDS (1 FOR JUNIORS & 1 FOR SENIORS) ARE SELECTED BY THE OJA AWARDS COMMITTEE FOR EITHER A SINGLE ACT OF SPORTSMANSHIP DURING THE AWARD PERIOD OR FOR A SPORTSMAN-LIKE ATTITUDE DEMONSTRATED OVER THE AWARD PERIOD.

3. ADREA BREGMAN MEMORIAL AWARD – THE RECIPIENTS OF THIS AWARD IS DEEMED THE INDIVIDUAL THAT HAS GIVEN THE MOST SERVICE TO THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA IN THE PAST YEAR. IT IS GIVEN IN MEMORY OF ADREA A. BREGMAN WHO ASSISTED WHENEVER SHE COULD AT TOURNAMENTS AT CONCESSIONS, AT SCORING TABLES OR HELPING ORGANIZE THE COMPETITION POOLS. THE RECIPIENT IS RECOGNIZED AS GIVING MOST SELFLESSLY TO THE OJA.

4. COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS – GIVEN TO BOTH A MALE & FEMALE EACH OF WHOM HAS THE HIGHEST POINT TOTALS FOR THE YEAR OF THOSE WHO HAVE COMPETED IN BOTH THE STATE CHAMPIONSHIP, & EITHER THE HIGH SCHOOL STATE CHAMPIONSHIP OR THE NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL CHAMPIONSHIP. THE RECIPIENTS MUST BE 11TH OR 12TH GRADERS AT THE TIME OF THE EVENTS.

TIEBREAKER SYSTEM (where points for the same award are equal):

1. The highest number of wins in competition.
2. The highest number of listed tournaments entered (including uncontested entries).
3. The highest number of matches played.
4. The higher average rank of all opponents defeated.
5. Selection by the player's coach where the tied players are team mates.
6. Selection by the OJA Awards Committee, based on the higher level of service & participation at non-competitive as well as competitive events.
7. Where 2 or more clubs have the same totals to determine the coaching awards, the club with the larger number of players having points in the respective division shall win. In the case where the clubs have the same totals & the same number of players having points, then the club with the larger number of total players in that particular division shall win that award.

SYMBOLS:

* = Competed in novice competition (JRS.); Competed in White-Green Belt division (SRS.); Teen competing against Intermediates; Intermediate competing against Bantams. (Earns 1/2 the point value of advanced divisions)

+ = Points were earned in the next younger age category & are 1/2 the original value (JRS.)

> = Moved up to older age category at date indicated. All individual points earned after the birthday will be carried in both the younger & older age categories. All points earned before the birthday will be carried in the younger age category, but only 1/2 the points will be carried to the older age category (older age categories are considered tougher competition)(JRS.)

< = Moved up from the lower age category at date indicated.

To determine the coaching awards, all points earned prior to the birthday shall be added to the team total in the younger category, while all points earned after the birthday shall be added to the team total in the older category (JRS.)

@ = Also competes in the Teen Division (all points earned in the Senior Division are added to the Teen Division; No points earned in the Teen Division are included in the Senior Division. 1/2-points earned in the Senior White-Green Belt Category are added as full points in the Teen Division)

= Changed clubs mid-year, points received are totaled for the individual &

separated for the coaching awards.
 \ = Time at which clubs were changed.
 X = Indicates the player was not an OJA member, though a resident of Oklahoma.
 No points are counted in any of the tallies. X besides point totals
